Emotional literacy is a term used to describe the ability to recognise and understand one's own and others' emotions, and to express emotions in ways that are constructive for the individual and for others. In this exploratory workshop, you can expect:

She is involved in teacher education and research in the areas of socio-emotional development and learning. Her central topics include Cooperative Learning (CL) and Socio-Emotional Learning (SEL) in combination with academic learning in heterogeneous groups and under challenging circumstances. Before coming to Hamburg in 2022, she worked in El Salvador (Central America) for three years, leading the development, implementation and evaluation of pedagogical programmes at the NGO Asociación Centro Nehemías.
